

Uploading a video to a Blackboard course using Mymedia/Kaltura

1. Create your video.

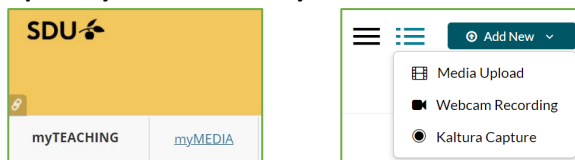
This can be done in many different ways;

- [Record a power point presentation](#) (open the presentation and click “Slideshow” in the top



- menu)
- Record your screen and/or webcam by using Kaltura. Kaltura is available for download in the Software center on your SDU computer.
- [Record your Zoom lecture](#) (please remember to tell the students that you are recording it)
- Record yourself writing on a blackboard or whiteboard using a conference cam or similar equipment.

2. Upload your video to MyMedia on e-learn.sdu.dk.



3. Enter a description and any tags. As a minimum, please tag yourself.

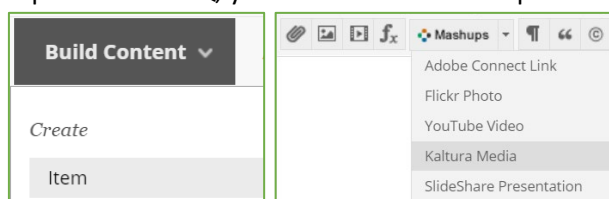


